Gun Safety: class for all attendees.

Learn safety first. Knowledge takes the fear away.

Shotgunning/Trap Basic or Intermediate

Learn to shoot a shotgun! The basics include learning about types and gauges, ammunition, chokes, loads to use, parts of a shotgun, safe handling and safety equipment. Shoot clays from a stationary trap house. Bring your own gun or try one of ours. (Ammo provided)

Handgun

SKEET SHOOTING - Basic or Intermediate

Shoot clays from the "high house" and "low house", different angles while traveling around the field to 8 different stations. Bring your own gun or try one of ours. (Ammo provided)

Try your hand at sporting clays with the assistance of an instructor. Basic shotgun or significant firearm experience required. Wooded course 10 stations (Shotgun not provided ammo is provided).
